### ***New Hearing Devices***

New hearing assist devices are now available during worship. The Worship and Music Committee is adding an option for people whose hearing device includes a tele-coil (t-coil) receiver (may also be called "induction loop option"). It is a loop/lanyard that is worn around the neck and replaces the earbuds of the current system. The loop allows the sound to come directly through the hearing aids improving the sound.
