New Hearing Devices

New hearing assist devices are now available during worship. The Worship and Music Committee is adding an option for people whose hearing device includes a tele-coil (t-coil) receiver (may also be called "induction loop option"). It is a loop/lanyard that is worn around the neck and replaces the earbuds of the current system. The loop allows the sound to come directly through the hearing aids improving the sound. Summer Choir is Here! - We are very excited that Summer Choir has begun. Summer Choir provides an opportunity for anyone to come join us in the **Sanctuary at 9:30 AM** for a short rehearsal.
