1. Lay Readers: Lay Readers get to participate in one of the most privileged moments of worship: the awesome task of reading God's Word.
2. Ushers: Usher hand out bulletins, help seat people, collect the offering, and welcome everyone who joins us in worship.
3. Communion Preparers, Servers, Clean Up:
 - a. Preparers: Communion Preparers prepare the elements to be served during Communion.
 - b. Servers: Communion Servers have the privileged responsibility of serving the elements during the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper.
 - c. Clean Up Crew: This crew is responsible for returning all the elements trays to the sacristy and cleaning the trays after worship.
4. AV Crew: Train with the Audio-Visual team to assist in all AV requirements during Sunday morning worship.
