Mission

One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS)- is one of the four main offerings of the PCUSA. One of the ministries receiving support from OGHS is Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA). Bernadette and her family are Syrian Christians who have withstood Syria's ever-worsening humanitarian and economic crisis, ongoing localized hostilities and collapsing infrastructure. Then the 7.8-magnitude earthquake struck in Feb. 2023, causing further damage to Bernadette's home. On their meager incomes, her family could not afford to move. With support from PDA, the Middle East Council of Churches stabilized her home. Bernadette's response: "Our prayers go out to all who stand by us and receive the Offering to ease our economic burdens, encouraging us to stay in our country so we may continue to witness to our Christian faith." The One Great Hour of Sharing offering will be collected on Easter.
