What is a circle?

Members of Presbyterian Women in the Congregation (PWC) are organized into several small groups, called circles, that meet regularly to provide an inclusive, caring community of women. These circles are an integral part of Presbyterian Women (PW), and are encouraged to use PW resources to strengthen and enrich this community of faith.

A circle is...

- Where faith is nurtured, and growth takes place through worship, study, fellowship and outreach
- Where women are challenged to stretch beyond their limits
- Where women move beyond the safe places of life and reach out to others
- Where Christian leadership is born, nurtured, and sent forth into ministry
- Where all women are welcome

The PW circles meet the 2nd Tuesday of each month September—May.
