Adult Work Trip - The Rolling Fork tornado was a violent EF4 tornado that struck Rolling Fork, Mississippi, on March 24, 2023, one of the strongest and deadliest U.S. tornadoes of that year with 17 fatalities. It caused catastrophic destruction across multiple Delta communities including nearly total destruction for sections of Rolling Fork and became one of the most studied tornadoes in recent history. Participate in the ongoing recovery by joining us on a work trip **October 10 - 17, 2026**. We will stay at Leland Presbyterian Church, a PDA housing location and have meals prepared by our chef.
