## Announcements

**June Recital** - This summer, Harvey Browne will be completing several important improvement and repair projects for both the sanctuary piano and pipe organ as part of our ongoing commitment to supporting music and worship at the church. The grand piano will receive detailed maintenance work to improve its touch, tone, responsiveness, and overall sound quality, while the pipe organ will undergo repairs and restoration work to help preserve the instrument and keep it functioning reliably for years to come. To celebrate the completion of this work, Harvey Browne will host a solo piano recital presented by Chris Harbeson-Borgelt on Sunday, **June 28** at 3:00 PM, offering an opportunity to hear the updated capabilities of the piano. **Join us for Summer Choir** - If you love to sing and build community, come join us for summer choir! We will rehearse each Sunday at 9:30 a.m. in the sanctuary to prepare that morning's anthem. No weekly commitment is required—come when you can! Together we'll make music, share laughter, and deepen our worship through creativity and connection.

**June Grocery Cart** - The Grocery Cart for June is for Hildegard House and House of Ruth.

- Hildegard House provides a home and compassionate care for individuals at the end of life who have no home or loved ones to care for them so they may die with dignity. The supplies Hildegard House is asking for this year are paper towels, bottled water, nitril gloves (Small-XL), rinse free shampoo caps, unscented lip balm, travel size hairbrushes and individual bags of chips.
- House of Ruth provides housing and support services for people with HIV/AIDS and their families who are homeless, at risk of losing their homes, or need financial help. The supplies House of Ruth is asking for this year are shampoo (no conditioner; all in one products are great), toothpaste, toilet paper, household cleaning spray or powder (Lysol, Clorox, Comet, etc.), men's deodorant, women's deodorant, dish soap (5-6oz bottles are best) and bar soap.
